Here are the instructions and an explanation with examples to fill out this form to file an environmental complaint with the Municipality of Nicoya about environmental crimes happening in Nosara District:

1. Reporting Party:

- Leave the box labeled "Anónimo" (Anonymous) unchecked unless you wish to remain anonymous throughout the process. Otherwise, include your full name, identification number, phone number, and email address.
- If you prefer to remain anonymous, simply proceed to the next section.

2. Accused Party:

- If you are aware of the identity of the person or entity responsible for the environmental crimes, provide their full name, identification number, and place of residence.
- If you do not know the identity of the person or entity, proceed to the next section.

3. Location of the Incident:

- Indicate Nosara as the district where the environmental crimes are taking place.
- Specify the neighborhood (barrio) if possible.
- Provide the exact address of the location where the crimes are occurring. Include any additional details that may help identify the affected area.

4. Reported Incident:

- Select the option that best describes the specific environmental crime you are reporting. For example:
- If it involves damage to a stream or bodies of water, check that option and explain if it's diversion, obstruction, or contamination.
- If it involves damage to forests or protected areas, check the corresponding option and describe the lucrative activity, deforestation, destruction, or pollution.
- If there are issues related to improper solid waste management, choose that option and specify if it's abandonment, burning, accumulation, or improper handling.
- Continue in the same manner with the other options, selecting those that accurately reflect the reported environmental crimes.

5. Previous Experience:

• If you have filed this complaint elsewhere, indicate "Yes" or "No" and provide details about the previous instance, mentioning the name of the institution or entity where the prior complaint was made.
